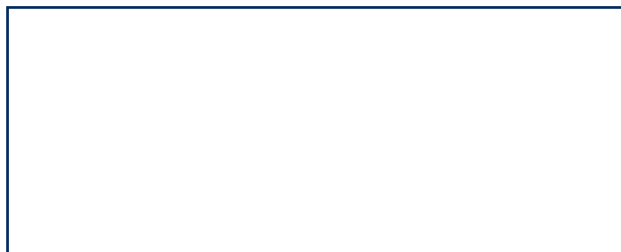
How do I Enrol?

Dispute Resolution and Grievance Procedure

If you are not happy about any part of your course at Langports English Language College, please tell us. We will do our best to meet your requests. The Principal is available to talk to you about any matter at any time. You are able to bring a friend to assist you at any time if you have a problem. If you are concerned about your accommodation, talk to our Student Services Manager. If you are concerned about the social activities program, talk to our Social Activities Coordinator. If you are concerned about your visa or fees, talk to the Principal. If you are unable to resolve a problem after talking to a teacher, a coordinator or a counsellor, please talk to the Principal.

If you are still not satisfied after you have spoken to the Principal, we can help you contact English Australia to arrange for mediation. This is a free service. You are able to bring a friend, and English Australia's mediators will help you and Langports reach a solution.

We are confident that we can resolve any difficulties. We want you to feel satisfied with your course at Langports. If you are concerned about the conduct of the college, please write to the representative of the Director General of Education (who has the power under the Education (Overseas Students) Act to suspend or cancel the registration of a provider or a course); the Senior Education Officer, Queensland Department of Education, Floor 18, Education House, 30 Mary Street, Brisbane, Queensland, Australia.

Activities Indemnity

Langports, and its Representatives and Staff will not be held liable for any loss, damages, death, illness or injuries to people or property which occurs whilst students are on any activity or excursion organised by Langports. It is the student's sole responsibility to take out insurance against all such risks, and we recommend that students traveling abroad take out comprehensive travel, accident and medical insurance in their own countries.

Transfer between colleges

- Students wishing to transfer between colleges must study for a minimum of 2 weeks at each campus.
- Students studying in the IEP or Cambridge courses cannot transfer between locations during their course. They may take a UFO course at one location and transfer to the other for Cambridge or IEP and visa versa.
- Langports offers to pay the cost of one transfer between locations, during a course.

Langports Refund Policy

Cancellations No refund can be made on the enrolment fee or accommodation placement fee. In the case of students holding a student visa, no refund on any fees will be made after they have entered Australia.

Study Cancellation:

- 4 weeks written notice - full refund.
- Less than 4 weeks before start of course - a cancellation charge equal to 4 weeks tuition will apply.
- No refund after studies have commenced.
- If visa application has been denied a full refund of fees will be made providing Langports receives written notification from the Australian Embassy.
- Students will be charged for any bank fees incurred.

Accommodation:

- 4 weeks written notice - full refund.
- Less than 4 weeks - a cancellation charge equal to 2 weeks rent will apply.
- After studies have commenced, 2 weeks notice must be given or a cancellation charge equal to 2 weeks rent will apply.

Airport Greeting:

No refund will be made if the student fails to notify Langports of their flight details or any change of details 48 hours before arrival.

Deferment Policy

Students must start their course on their allocated start date, except in exceptional special circumstances.

Students that wish to defer their start date and their course must give one week's written notice. If notice is less than one week Langports will charge one week's tuition fee.

Students that do not arrive on the designated start date and do not give notice of deferment will automatically lose one week's tuition. If notice of deferment is not received within 48 hours of course commencement the course will be cancelled.

Please Note: There are no refunds for public holidays or time missed during the period of your booked course. There are no refunds given if you withdraw voluntarily or are dismissed from the program for unsatisfactory attendance or behaviour, or if you are in breach of Australian Government regulations or the Langports Code of Conduct.

Refunds will be paid within 4 weeks of student default. In the case where Langports cancels a course, all course monies will be refunded within 2 weeks of the cancellation.

Any refund will be fully paid in the same currency in which the fees were paid, unless payment in that currency is impracticable.

Any refund will be paid directly to the person who has entered into this contract with Langports, unless the person directs Langports in writing, to pay the refund to someone else. If the refund is paid in your country a \$40 transfer fee will be charged.

Requests for a refund must be made to the Principal in writing. This agreement does not remove the right to take further action under Australia's consumer protection laws. Refunds, if Langports defaults cannot be covered by this agreement. Such situations are covered by the provisions of the ESOS Act 2000 and by ESOS Regulations 2001.
