Survival English - FAQs

What content is taught in the Survival English class?

The program is designed for anyone who considers travelling to Australia in the future to learn English and/or find work. It is an elementary/pre-intermediate program that helps you improve your basic grammar, conversation, vocabulary and pronunciation. You will learn English to 'survive' once you arrive in Australia and also prepares you to get a job here. This program will give you a kick-start to your experience once you are able to travel to Australia in the future.

What is the one-on-one session?

Langports is known for its personalised approach and we are including a short one-on-one session at the end of each week to ensure that the students get feedback from their teacher and additional learning tips and support. This session will be approx. 10 minutes with the teacher.

Do you offer the course for students who have already enrolled and have not started a face-to-face course yet?

Yes! If you have already paid for your face-to-face classes and are coming in the future, we can offer you a discount for this Survival English program.

What is a demo class?

You are invited to join our demo classes for 30 minutes to trial the class and see what kind of experience you can expect from the program. We will have set times for this and you must be able to attend the set time, otherwise we are able to send a recording of the session to you if you are unable to attend.

When do you offer a demo class for students if they requested it?

We will offer demo classes every one or two weeks (depending on the demand). Please book using this link <u>https://bit.ly/Booking-DemoClass</u>

Can I choose which day I want to study? For example Monday & Wednesday?

We are organising two classes to begin with but they must have a minimum number of students for us to run them. You can let us know your preference on which days suit you, but we cannot guarantee that you will get your first choice. Please be available to study any of the days and Langports will communicate 1 week before which day your classes will run.

When do you decide if you run the course or not on each start date?

We will contact you and decide to run the course 1 week before the start date. If we decide to cancel the course, you may postpone to the next intake or receive a full refund.

What study material am I going to use during the course?

You will receive "live" classes from a Langports teacher. The teacher will provide PDFs and learning materials to you.

What is the minimum age to join the program?

The minimum age is 6 years, however, if you are younger, please contact us and we may be able to consider a junior program in the future.

Can students who returned home during COVID-19 join this program?

Primarily, the program is designed for students who have not been to Australia yet but are preparing to go in the future. It is also designed for students who may want to "test out" Langports from offshore before they choose to buy face-to-face classes. This is a new course, which is designed differently to our UFO English and will not match past students' needs.

How can I prepare for this program?

As this is an online program, students are required to participate and also have the right equipment to join. For example, you will need a webcam and headphones to join and share your video. You will need to be independent and do homework and self-study to really improve your English in the short period. You will have "live" classes for 4 hours per week, but improving your English can continue outside the virtual classroom if you really work hard.
