- A copy of your university transcript in English (only if required)
- Passport & visa information
- Langports enrolment form

2. Application assessment:

- Internship coordinator will assess the candidate's application
- A short online interview with the Internship Coordinator may be required

3. Upload all your documents onto the online portal (Eligible Candidate only):

- All internship application form
- Resume in English
- Statement of Internship Objectives in English
- Passport
- Copy of Visa
- Photo (should be a professional photo)
- Video (only if required)
- A copy of your university transcript in English (only if required)
- Pay the application deposit (non-refundable): \$550 for PIP / \$1100 for STEM

4. Interview with a Potential Host Organisation:

- Internship confirmed
- Finalise the full payment of the program with Langports as per the offer letter and invoice

5. Completion of internship

- The student completes the internship (regular follow-ups from our internship coordinator + exit evaluation)

6. The student receives a Certificate of Completion of the internship
